Content: This course covers concepts such as Ratios and Proportions, the Number System, Expressions and Equations, Statistics and Probability, and Geometry. This course will address the California State Standards for grade 7 and help expand students' critical thinking skills.

Expectations:

You will be expected to be respectful, on-time, and productive on a daily basis in the classroom. You are also expected to be prepared to learn and actively involved in the class. I expect that you refrain from using foul language. Finally, when class is in session, you are expected to have all electronic equipment turned **off**, not on silent mode.

Procedures:

- No food or drinks in the classroom. Bottled water is okay.
- Students must be in their seats when the bell rings.
- The tardy policy in place by the district will be followed.
- Cell phones and other electronic devices have to be turned off at **all** times.
- Detention will be given to students who do not follow classroom procedures and interfere with the learning of other students.

Attendance and Class Work:

Attendance is extremely important to student success. Most math lessons build on previous lessons. Therefore, missing lessons will limit a student's achievement. Daily participation from all students is expected during the various class activities. The activities include a daily warm-up, note taking, class discussions, and in-class assignments.

Notes:

All students are expected to keep a current set of notes in their spiral-bound notebook from the ones given in class.

Homework:

Homework will be assigned on a daily basis, and should be completed in **pencil**. Students will be given a math workbook that includes homework pages. I will assign whatever I feel will help support the skills taught in class, but students can complete more if they feel they need more practice. Homework packets will be collected every Friday and should include all homework for the week, and the warm-up/objectives sheet I provide them every Monday. No late homework will be accepted unless the parent/guardian provides a valid excuse and the student is willing to work on the missing assignments during lunchtime in my room. (C107)

Tests/Quizzes:

Tests and Quizzes will be announced in advance and will address all previously covered material. Re-takes may be offered at times.

Extra Assistance:

Please feel free to ask for extra help if you feel you need it. Don't hesitate to ask questions during class. I am here to help you. Help will be offered during lunchtime; days will be announced at a later time.
